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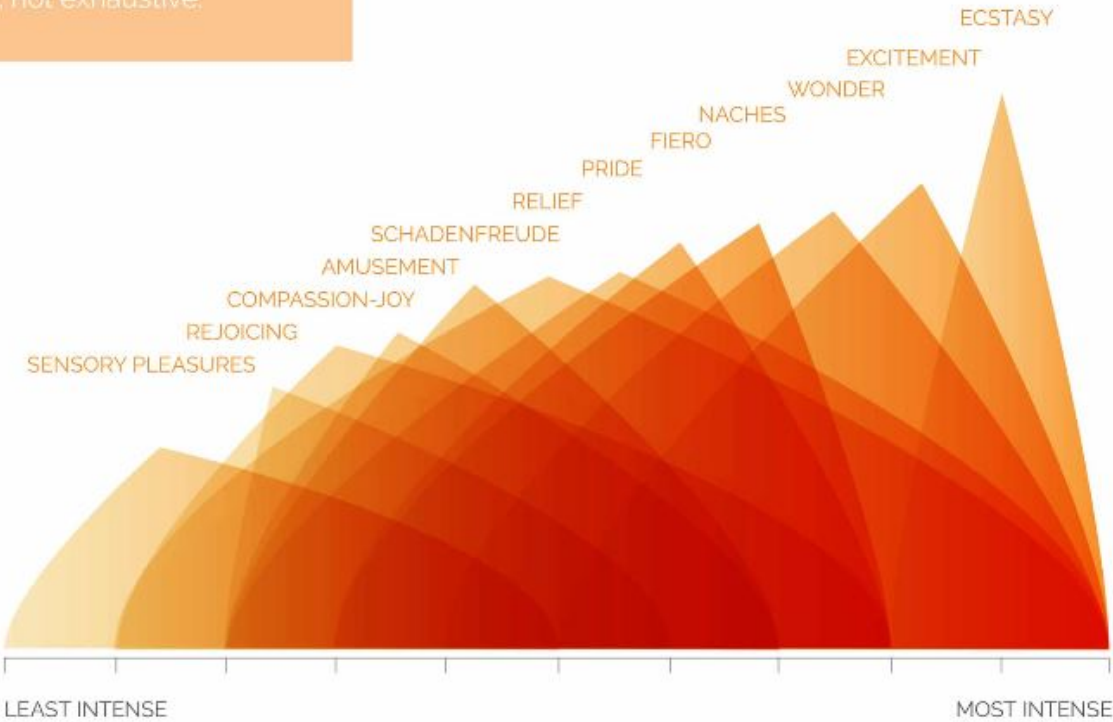

Each emotion contains a number of related states, which differ in intensity. The states shown here are representative, not exhaustive.

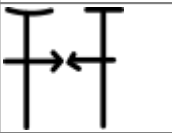
