In early Western thought, Plato's idealism held that all things have [such an](#) essence—an idea or form. In Categories, Aristotle similarly proposed that all objects have a substance that, as George Lakoff put it, make the thing what it is, and without which it would [be](#) not that kind of thing. The contrary view—non-essentialism—denies the need to posit [such an](#) essence.
